How much Bess will India install in 2025?

With its wide applications across sectors, the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) estimates that India will install 34 GW or 136 GWh of BESS capacity by the end of this decade. Recent developments further support this growth, starting in 2025. India will add 1.8 GWh of BESS in 2025.

What is India's Bess capacity in 2024?

As of March 2024, India's BESS capacity was around 111.7 MW/219.1 MWh, but has been rapidly adding capacity, with numerous new projects being commissioned and tendered in early to mid-2025, including large-scale utility systems. Tenders for 3625 MW /8100 MWh of standalone BESS were floated in 2024 alone. BESS is critical for:
