How has E-GP changed Bangladesh's government procurement system?

The e-GP portal streamlines the process, with over 80% of procurements now conducted online. This shift has boosted transparency and saved an estimated \$1.4 billion in 2023 alone. Overall, Bangladesh's government procurement system is on a promising trajectory towards efficient and accountable allocation of public resources.

What is E-GP & how does it work in Bangladesh?

Since 2012, the e-GP system witnessed an exponential growth over a decade with wider adoption of the electronic tendering across the government procuring entities (PEs) and private sector tenderers. Now-defunct Central Procurement Technical Unit (CPTU), which has been transformed into Bangladesh Public Procurement Authority (BPPA), introduced e-GP.

What are the different types of Bangladesh government procurement?

The most popular categories for Bangladesh government procurement are - Bangladesh Government releases various kinds of tenders - Bangladesh RFP- A document outlining the Bangladeshi government's requirements for a proposed project or service, inviting vendors to submit detailed proposals.

How big is Bangladesh's government procurement market?

Bangladesh's government procurement market is a behemoth, steadily growing to reach over 7.1 trillion BDT(? \$71 billion) in 2021. This represents a significant chunk of the nation's GDP, hovering around 12%. The e-GP portal streamlines the process, with over 80% of procurements now conducted online.

What are the new modules of public procurement in E-GP system?

Some new modules of public procurement have been developed and added to e-GP System. These are Tenderer Database, International Competitive Tendering (ICT), Direct Procurement, e-Audit, Framework Agreement, Red Flag Monitoring and Service Procurement.

When did E-GP start in Bangladesh?

The e-GP system started its journey in Bangladesh with the Hon'ble Prime Minister inaugurating e-GP portal on June 2, 2011. Since 2012, the e-GP system witnessed an exponential growth over a decade with wider adoption of the electronic tendering across the government procuring entities (PEs) and private sector tenderers.
