How long does it take to charge a watch?

This typically takes about 10-12 hours to fully charge the watch. However, it is important to note that the watch will continue to charge as long as it is exposed to light, so you may not need to charge it for the full 10-12 hours. In addition, the watch will automatically enter a "sleep" mode when it is not being worn to conserve energy.

Who makes CL 888 watches?

Cal. CL-888 was produced by Claro Watch SA (Semag). It used a Chinese Sea-Gull ST1612 ebauche but was re-manufactured in Switzerland so it could be sold as Swiss Made. Production ended in 2009 once Claro began producing Cal. VB9832.

How long does it take a watch to start running?

The Longines caliber L888 is 3-hand automatic watch movement based on the ETA caliber A31.L11. It is a Swiss made with 21 jewels, produced by ETA (Swatch Group).



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For the one watch I have with a power reserve, I usually wind it to about 5-10 hours and it will be fully wound (40 hrs) within a couple hours of strapping it on my wrist.
